A motion was made to have 4 of the 6 Units at South Bay for chronic homeless Chesapeake residents by Annie White-Guertin and seconded by Alisa Winston. Grand opening scheduled Feb 2 at 10:30.

Would like to have donation of new adult size gloves, hats, socks, for those homeless person completing surveys.
