## Hot Projects

### CASCADE BOULEVARD PARK

Parks and Recreation / Public Works: The Notice to Award the contract to Branham Electric was issued on October 12, 2012. Notice to proceed is expected by the end of the week, with project completion being in Spring 2013.

### CONSOLVO PARK

Parks and Recreation / Public Works: The contract with Conrad Brothers is being processed. The contract includes: lighting for one of two practice ball fields, safety netting, chain link fence for the area adjacent to Bainbridge Blvd., sidewalks, and improvements to the paved parking area. Field improvements will be included as operation costs.

### DERELICT STRUCTURES

City Attorney: The City's Attorney's Office is working on changes to the associated ordinances. They expect to be completed by the end of November.

### POINDEXTER STREET

### SOUTH NORFOLK LIBRARY

Libraries / Public Works: Work has begun. The construction progress will be monitored through monthly project meetings.

## Project Updates

### UTILITY-RELATED PAVEMENT REPAIRS

Public Utilities: Public Utilities is finding and fixing cave-ins associated with sanitary sewer leaks. The repair to 5008 Neal Street was completed. The list of repairs underway is as follows: 1600 block of Jackson Street, 2913 Rodgers Street, and 2901 Rodgers Street. There are several locations being managed; they will be repaired if they become unsafe or nonoperational. They are as follows: Bainbridge Blvd. at Park Ave; 904 Avalon Ave.; 2700 Block of Bainbridge Blvd.; Westwood Ave. and Avalon Ave.; 1333 Chesapeake Ave.; 2020 Portlock Rd.; Faye St. between Omar St. and Mark St.
