PROJECTS

DOMINION BOULEVARD SOUTH WIDENING PROJECT

The Dominion Boulevard Improvement Project will see new traffic patterns at the Cedar Road intersection over the next several months.

First, westbound Cedar Road traffic headed to northbound Dominion Blvd. will no longer go underneath the new overpass to turn right onto Dominion, but will instead use the future on-ramp to the east of the overpass. In early spring, southbound Dominion Blvd. traffic will move up onto the overpass at Cedar Road, and northbound traffic will use both ramps to cross Cedar, in a similar pattern to what is currently at the Dominion Lakes intersection.

SNJB TOLL INCREASE

On January 1, 2016, the South Norfolk Jordan Bridge introduced a new toll rate. The toll for 2-axle vehicles is now \$2.00 with an E-ZPass, \$3.50 for registered Pay By Plate customers, and \$4.75 for Pay By Mail users. The rate proportionately increases for additional vehicle axles. The bridge, which links South Norfolk with Portsmouth, is a privately owned and operated facility. DEEP CREEK PARK SECURITY CAMERAS

Recently, security flash cameras were installed at Deep Creek, Elizabeth River, and Lakeside Parks. The cameras are a proactive deterrence and investigative tool used in apprehension procedures. When motion is detected, the cameras will take high-resolution digital photographs, and the voice-activated alarm warns intruders.
