GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF CLASS

The purpose of the class is to repair and maintain bridge. The class is responsible for inspecting bridge and equipment, operating tools for repair and maintenance, and repairing and maintaining equipment. The class works according to set procedures under direct supervision.

TYPICAL TASKS	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Inspects bridge and related equipment such as lighting, gates, and emergency equipment to ensure operating order and determine need for repairs. • Operates tools for repair and maintenance such as dump trucks and sandblasters. • Repairs or assists with repairing bridge and equipment such as damaged parts, wooden structures, and pouring concrete. • Maintains equipment and grounds including greasing and lubricating mechanical moving parts, painting, and mowing grass. • Prepares materials for and/or performs construction of concrete forms. • Performs related tasks as necessary such as assisting with bridge operations, toll collection, and security. • Performs other related duties as assigned. 	

GENERAL STANDARDS	
Data Involvement	Computes or performs arithmetic operations using data or information.
Interpersonal/People Involvement	Speaks or signals to people to convey or exchange information.
Reasoning Requirements	Performs semi-skilled work involving set procedures but solves frequent problems.
Mathematical Requirements	Uses basic algebra involving variables and formulas, basic geometry involving plane and solid figures, circumferences, areas, and volumes; computes ratios, rates, and percents.
Language Requirements	Reads technical instructions, procedures manuals, and charts to solve practical problems; composes routine and specialized reports, forms, and business letters; speaks compound sentences using normal grammar and word form.
Mental Requirements	Performs manual and technical tasks requiring a wide range of procedures and requiring intensive understanding of a restricted field or complete familiarity with the functions of a unit or small division of an operating agency; requires normal attention with short periods of concentration for accurate results or occasional exposure to unusual pressure.
Decisions/Supervisory Control	Guides others, making frequent decisions, affecting the individual, coworkers, and others who depend on the service or product.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, AND SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS	
Vocational/Educational Requirement	Requires a high school diploma or GED and combination of education and experience equivalent to satisfactory completion of one year of college education.
Experience	In addition to satisfying the vocational/educational standard, this class requires a minimum of six months of related, full-time equivalent experience.
Special Certifications and Licenses	Requires a valid driver's license and a driving record that is in compliance with City Driving Standards; may require a CDL (depending upon assigned division).
Special Requirements	Performance of essential functions may require exposure to confined spaces. Employees may be expected to work hours in excess of their normally scheduled hours in response to short-term department needs and/or City-wide emergencies. Emergency
