Chesapeake Juvenile Services (CJS) is committed to ensuring a safe and humane environment for all residents. An important part of a safe and humane environment includes freedom from sexual misconduct. Residents' rights and safeguards are in place for the protection from sexual misconduct.

“Sexual misconduct” is a term used to describe certain kinds of prohibited behavior. Sexual misconduct includes sexual harassment, over familiarity, and retaliation.

CJS cannot and will not tolerate any form of sexual misconduct. We recognize the worth of each resident and strive to treat residents with respect and dignity. State statute prohibits resident abuse and CJS maintains a zero-tolerance policy with regard to sexual misconduct.

Any alleged abuse (including sexual contact) of a resident should immediately be reported and will be investigated.
