

2020 Fall Adult Softball Season COVID Guidelines

Teams:

- Self-screening is required. Coaches and players should take their temperature prior to coming to the ball field. If you have a fever or are not feeling well, please stay home.
- Should not enter dugout until the other team exits and staff has sanitized.
- Should provide hand sanitizer for their players.
- Bats must be outside of the dugout prior to the game for inspection.
- No sharing of equipment permitted.

- Will provide their own game balls. Balls are to be sanitized by the teams each inning by wipes provided by the team. None will be provided for you.
- Must adhere to the social distancing requirements whenever possible.
- Pre-game & post-game handshakes/high fives are not permitted.
- No gathering in the parking lots including tailgating
- Coaches meeting: 1 coach per team and must stay 6 feet apart.

Players:

- Mask are recommended especially where social distancing is not possible
- No huddles
- Encouraged to follow 6 feet social distancing guidelines whenever possible
- Should bring their own water, hand sanitizer and face masks
- Should wash/sanitize your hands often
- No sharing of equipment permitted
- Should comply with social distancing standards in the dugouts. Please use the extended dugout area which is the bleachers and area directly behind the dugout.
- No handshakes or high fives permitted
- No gathering in the parking lots including tailgating

Umpires:

- Should self –screen by taking their temperature prior to coming to the ball park. If you have a fever or are not feeling well, please stay home.
- Allowed to wear masks and gloves
- Adhere to social distancing guidelines whenever possible.
- Encouraged to follow 6 feet social distancing guidelines.
- Should provide their own hand sanitizer.
- Home plate meetings will be limited to the umpire and one coach from each team. Social distancing required.
