Business Beautification Award Winner Announced

Girl Scout Council of Colonial Coast at 912 Cedar Road was recently honored as the 2016 Chesapeake Business Beautification Award winner. "A Place for Girls" is the headquarters and program center for the Girl Scout Council of the Colonial Coast. This headquarters supports services for over 13,000 girls and 7,000 volunteers through southeast Virginia and northeast North Carolina. The neatly maintained grounds around the building provide staff and visitors with a tranquil setting including a small garden area with a pond framing their flagpole area. Benches and nature and tree identification signage are placed along the perimeter of the parking area. And, for a bonus feature, the facility maintains an 8.5 acre nature area with boardwalk and trails along Bells Mill Creek, a tributary of the Elizabeth River.
