

NORTHWEST RIVER PARK

Cabin Information and Regulations

Advance Reservations

- Applicant must be 18-years-of-age to rent; applicant must occupy cabin.
- Reservations may be made during the calendar year of the rental.
- Two-night minimum reservation required.
- No more than 4 people/cabin. *Exception:* 5th person no older than 5-years-old.
- Reservation and fee can be made:
 - ◆ **in person**—cash or check, or
 - ◆ **by mail**—check only.
- Reservation requires a \$50 non-refundable reservation deposit/cabin, to be applied to first night of reservation.
- Balance due upon arrival.



Cabin

Check-in/Check-out

- Check-in: 3 pm; check-out: 11 am.
- Applicant must check-in before store closes; time varies during the season. Call store (757) 421-7151 for times.



For the safety of our campers...

- Quiet hour—10 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Campers are restricted to the campground after sunset.
- Clotheslines between campsites and the bath-house must be removed at sundown.
- Swimming is prohibited.
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
- Fireworks, including sparklers, are prohibited.
- Possession of bows and arrows, air guns or sling-shots is prohibited.

CABIN FEES

- April 1 through the Thurs. prior to Memorial Day weekend and Mon after the second weekend in Oct-Nov 30. (\$65/night)
- Memorial Day weekend through the 2nd weekend in October:
 - ◆ \$65/night, Sun.-Thurs.
 - ◆ \$85/night, Fri. & Sat.
- Upon check-in, a \$100 damage/cleaning deposit required; refunded upon departure.

Pets and Smoking

- Pets and smoking are not permitted in any of the cabins.
- No pets permitted if you are renting a cabin.

Vehicles

- A 15-mph-speed limit is enforced throughout the park.
- Motorcycles and mini-bikes may not be driven in the campground area except as transportation to or from the park.
- Bicycles are permitted on gravel roads only.



Cabin Amenities

- Log, queen-size bed
- Log, table and chairs
- Heat & air conditioning; ceiling fan
- Refrigerator
- Microwave (Cooking only in microwave, no hotplates or grills in cabins.)
- No grills or cooking allowed on the porch; outdoor grill available nearby.
- **All bedding is to be supplied by the renter.**
- Front porch bench
- Log, full-size futon
- Vanity and sink



Water

- Water spigots are for obtaining water for your campsite.
- Washing of vehicles, dishes, clothes, pets or your person at these spigots is prohibited.
- Do not leave a hose attached to a water spigot unless you have a gated "Y" fitting.

Trash and Dump-station

- All refuse and garbage is to be placed in the dumpster located at the dump station near the entrance to the camping area.
- All campsites are to be kept clean and presentable.

Cleaning

- It is the responsibility of the renter to leave the cabin in the condition in which it was found.
- Renters are required to leave refrigerator empty and wiped clean.
- Deposit all trash in the dumpster.
- All damages and cleaning issues must be reported to the office within 30 minutes of your check-in.

Fires

1. Fires are restricted to the cooking fire-pit.
2. Fire pit must not be left unattended.
3. Do not burn trash or any material which can carry sparks aloft.
4. The cutting of any tree, dead or alive, is prohibited.
5. You may pick up deadwood from the ground.
6. Fires are to be no larger than knee-high.



Parking

- No more than 2 vehicles/site.
