

- 1-All Chesapeake City Jail arraignments and bond hearings will be done by video at 12:00pm each day.
- 2-Hampton Roads Regional Jail arraignments and bond hearings will be done by video at 9:00am each day.
- 3-Individuals who have retained counsel and counsel has provided a letter of representation, with dates, no one need appear for the arraignment.
- 4-Any matter that has an agreed upon continuance, please do so with an agreed order prior to the court date.
- 5-All proceedings will be conducted at the counsel tables not the podiums.
- 6-Do not approach the bench
- 7-We will be limiting the people allowed in the courtrooms. The only individuals that will be in the courtrooms will be those that were subpoena or summons for court, parties of the case and attorneys on the case.
- 8-If you are sick, please do not come to court. If individuals in your case are sick, please do not bring them to court. Call the court, or inform a Deputy of the illness.
- 9-First time Preliminary Protective Order petitions will be done by reading of the Affidavit
- 10-Beginning March 24th, the Drivers License Presentations are cancelled until further notice.
- 11-Out of custody criminal trials will be set out three (3) months from the arraignment date.
- 12-In custody criminal trials will be set out eight (8) weeks from the arraignment date.
- 13-If you have out of town clients, please inform the Court, so a telephonic hearing can be requested.

We are closely following this evolving situation, as it develops, and are working to create and share guidance to keep everyone informed and help the Court tend to business, while being mindful of our community and staff.
