

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Proposed Improvements:

- Signalize the intersection
- Add crosswalks and pedestrian signals
- Upgrade sidewalks and curb ramps
- Provide left turn lanes from Albemarle Dr
- Drainage and utility improvements

Project Budget:

- \$1.35M (Design, RoW and Construction)

Construction Impacts:

- Minor traffic impacts are expected throughout the project.
- Existing traffic patterns will be maintained during construction.

Schedule:


- Construction Start—January 2020

RIGHT-OF-WAY

Impacted property owners will be informed of the exact location of easements during the right-of-way acquisition process and prior to construction. Currently, there are three parcels affected by the project.
