South Norfolk Jordan Bridge TOLL INCREASE

The Transportation Toll Facility Advisory Committee (TTFAC) is an advisory committee that provides recommendations to the City Council regarding tolls in Chesapeake.

The purpose of this citizen information meeting is to review the scheduled toll increase for the South Norfolk Jordan Bridge and to receive public comment. The South Norfolk Jordan Bridge is a private facility owned and operated by United Bridge Partners which has authority over its toll schedule. Starting January 1, 2019, base toll rates are scheduled to increase by 10 cents. The TTFAC will seek input from the public and from the owner and operator of the transportation facility regarding the scheduled toll increase and will report its findings to Chesapeake City Council. The meeting will start promptly at 6:30 P.M. and will conclude after all registered speakers have concluded their remarks.

The meeting provides an opportunity for any individual, association, citizens' group or governmental agency to offer comments for the record. Representatives from the South Norfolk Jordan Bridge will provide a presentation and will be available, along with City staff and TTFAC members, to answer questions. Comment sheets will be available and may be submitted at the meeting or by email or phone by January 3.
