Agenda: Discussion of the November 2018 General Election.

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m.

Mary Lynn Pinkerman updated the board on the issue of Hart InterCivic's error in packaging of ballots for the Silverwood precinct. There was no charge for the extra ballots needed for the election and the company sent an e-mail accepting all responsibility for the error.

There were several Election Official discussions:

- Void vs. casting an abandoned ballot
- Dealing with Absentee Ballot voters in the precinct
- Proper IDs – not checking ID, not accepting acceptable IDs
- Statement of Results – completeness, training all officers, not just Chief and Assistant Chief, how to include Federal only ballots
- Studying the manual in addition to going to training session
- Standing too close to the scanner

Mary Lynn and George are working with Mary Moneypenny from IT to look into moving lines of some precincts to adjust for population, and upcoming redistricting and the possibility of both a June and September primary due to the redistricting. They are also looking into eliminating the use of schools as polling places, when possible.

The next meeting is pending information packets from Mary Moneypenny regarding precinct line changes.
