

## ABSENTEE AND EARLY VOTING IN CHESAPEAKE

### Can I vote early?

You can vote early at your local registrar's office beginning 45 days before Election Day and ending the Saturday before Election Day. Before visiting your local registrar's office, you may wish to check your registration status at [www.elections.virginia.gov](http://www.elections.virginia.gov).

- Starting 45 days before Election Day, visit your local registrar's office or a satellite voting location in your county or city to vote early.
- You **do not** have to have a reason or fill out an application to vote early.
- At the registrar's office or satellite voting location, you **must** provide your name and address and show an acceptable form of ID or sign an ID Confirmation Statement.
- If acceptable identification is not provided, you must sign an ID Confirmation Statement or a provisional ballot will be offered.

### Applying to Vote Absentee By Mail

Apply online to vote by mail at [www.elections.virginia.gov](http://www.elections.virginia.gov) or

You can download and complete the "Vote by Mail Application Form" from [www.elections.virginia.gov](http://www.elections.virginia.gov) and **return** the completed and signed form to your local registrar's office by mail, fax, or scanned attachment to an email.

- After the registrar processes your application, you will receive your ballot in the mail. Please note: ballots can be mailed out to applicants starting 45 days prior to the relevant election date.
- Carefully review the instructions to complete and return your ballot to your local registrar by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day. If you are returning your ballot by-mail, it must be postmarked on or before Election Day and received by your registrar by noon on the third day after the election.

Military and overseas voters can find specific information regarding absentee voting on [www.fvap.gov](http://www.fvap.gov).

After applying, you can check to see if your absentee application was received, and whether your ballot was sent and received by going to [www.elections.virginia.gov](http://www.elections.virginia.gov).

## VOTING ON ELECTION DAY

### Where will I vote?

When you register to vote your registrar will send you a voter information notification. The notification will tell you the name of your precinct and where you will vote. You must always vote in the precinct where you live. You can also use the "Where to vote" Link available under the "casting a ballot" tab at [www.elections.virginia.gov](http://www.elections.virginia.gov).

### What do I need to bring with me to vote?

Virginia law requires all voters to provide an acceptable form of identification at the polls. Acceptable forms of identification include:

- Voter confirmation documents you received after you registered to vote
- Virginia DMV-issued Driver's License or Identification Card
- Valid United States Passport
- Any ID card issued by the US, Virginia, or a local Virginia government
- Any student ID card issued by a US university or community college
- Valid student ID issued by a public school or private school in Virginia
- Employer-issued photo ID card
- Any current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document with your name and address
- An ID Confirmation Statement

\* Your DMV license may be used at any time. Virginia law permits an expired DMV license to be used for voting purposes.

### Can I vote if I forget my ID?

If you get to your polling place without acceptable ID, you can sign an ID statement affirming your identity, you will be able to vote a regular ballot.

If you do not sign an ID statement to affirm your identity you may vote a provisional ballot. You will be provided instructions to ensure your vote will count.

### When are the polls open?

The polls open at 6:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m. If you are in line when the polls close, you can still vote.

### When do general elections take place?

For most offices, general elections are held on the Tuesday following the first Monday in November. For city and town offices, general elections take place the first Tuesday in May.

### What is a party primary?

The Democratic and Republican parties can choose their candidates by either a primary election or by a party meeting. If a party uses a primary for the November election, it will be held on the second Tuesday in June. In Chesapeake, May elections (Council & School Board) are non-partisan; therefore, no primary is held.

### Can anyone vote in a primary election?

If you are a registered voter, you can vote in any primary election since Virginia does not register by party. If both parties are holding a primary in your election district, you may only vote in one party's primary.
