Susan called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.

The board discussed the early voting logistics as there will be a June 21st Republican Primary but no June Democratic Primary. There was discussion of historical turnouts for June primaries and whether early voting satellites were necessary.

David made a motion to only hold early voting, as required, at the Registrar's Office for the June 21st Republican Primary. Duane seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Mary Lynn reported what she had found when researching what other surrounding localities are paying polling places to use their facilities for elections. The board discussed that the amount had not increased since at least 1997 and that if it was increased it may help keep current facilities and better chances of obtaining new ones in the future.

David made a motion pay polling places \$250.00 for use of their facility each election beginning July 1, 2022. Duane seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Being no further business, the meeting was adjourned by Susan at 10:30 a.m.
