

VOTING ABSENTEE IN CHESAPEAKE

Can I vote absentee?

Yes, if you are a registered voter and you will be absent on Election Day from Chesapeake because of the following:

- Student attending school
- Spouse of student attending school
- Business
- Personal business or vacation
- Active duty in the Merchant Marine or Armed Forces
- Spouse or dependent living with an active duty member in the Merchant Marines or Armed Forces
- Temporarily residing outside the U.S., cohabitant spouse or dependent
- Temporarily residing outside the U.S. for employment, cohabitant spouse or dependent
- Disability or illness
- Primary and personally responsible for the care of a disabled/fill family member confined at home
- Pregancy
- Religious obligations
- Working and commuting to/from for 11 or more hours between 6:00 am and 7:00 pm on Election Day
- Confined, awaiting trial
- Confined, convicted of a misdemeanor
- An electoral board member, registrar, officer of election, or custodian of voting equipment

How do I get the ballot?

Call, write or stop by the Registrar's Office located at 411 Cedar Road and ask for an absentee ballot application. The application is also now available at www.sbe.virginia.gov.

When can I apply for an absentee ballot?

You can request an absentee ballot application as early as 12 months before an election. All applications for mail ballots must be received in the Registrar's Office no later than 5:00 p.m. on the Tuesday before the election date. The last date to vote an absentee ballot in person is by 5:00 p.m. on the Saturday before the election.

How do I vote the ballot?

You will receive instructions with the ballot. Vote the ballot as soon as you receive it. Put it in the envelope provided. MAIL IT OR HAND DELIVER IT PERSONALLY to the Registrar so that it is received before 7:00 p.m. on Election Day. No one else may deliver it for you. You cannot return a "VOTED BALLOT" to your precinct polling place on Election Day.

If I am put in the hospital shortly before the election, can I vote?

Yes, if you are a registered voter and you are put in the hospital on or after the seventh day before an election or if you go to the hospital in the two weeks before an election and your condition prevents you from requesting an application sooner than the seventh day before the election. Call your voter registrar as soon as possible but not later than noon on the day before the election. Ask for an emergency absentee ballot application. You will need someone to pick up the application for you and return it after you complete it. This person must then deliver your ballot to you and return it after you vote. Choose someone who is at least 18 years old.

VOTING ON ELECTION DAY

Where will I vote?

When you register to vote your registrar will send you a voter information card. The card will tell you the name of your precinct and where you will vote. You must always vote in the precinct where you live. Virginia voters must provide identification at the polls on election day. Acceptable forms of identification include:

- Virginia voter identification card
- Virginia driver's license
- Military ID
- Federal, state or local government ID
- Employer issued photo ID card
- Social Security card

Registered voters without identification at the polls may still vote if they sign an affirmation of identification form.

If you have moved, changed your address or are unsure of your voting precinct, call the Voter Registrar's Office at 277-9797 to confirm your polling location!

When are the polls open?

The polls open at 6:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m. If you are in line when the polls close, you can still vote.

When do general elections take place?

For most offices, general elections are held on the Tuesday following the first Monday in November. For city and town offices, however, general elections take place the first Tuesday in May.

What is a party primary?

The Democratic and Republican parties can choose their candidates by either a primary election or by a party meeting. If a party uses a primary for the November election, it will be held on the second Tuesday in June. In Chesapeake, May elections (Council & School Board) are non-partisan - therefore, no primary is held in March.

Can anyone vote in a primary election?

If you are a registered voter, you can vote in any primary election since Virginia does not register by party. If both parties are holding a primary in your election district, you may only vote in one party's primary.
