POCATY RIVER WATERSHED STORM DRAINAGE SYSTEM

The City of Chesapeake Department of Public Works Operations is evaluating the condition of the lead and connector ditches in the Pocaty River Watershed Storm Drainage System. The field crews you may see working in the next few weeks represent the personnel from Public Works Stormwater Operations.

These crews may be observed along storm water ditches and along the street where the ditches are located. We anticipate the majority of the work will be along the ditches but it may require field crew to enter your property to access these ditches and or collect ditch information. A map of the Pocaty River Watershed area and the extents of current field investigation/survey locations is located on page 2 of this notice.
