**3. Meeting Discussion:**

Mr. Davis initiated a discussion on the South Norfolk Jordan Bridge Public Hearing, which was held on May 30, 2012. There was only one citizen in attendance at the Public Hearing. Mr. Davis informed the Committee that he felt that the Public Hearing was not well attended despite FIGG's constant efforts to communicate with the public by holding "Talks in the Park" every other Saturday, which allowed citizens the opportunity to view the construction progress and ask questions. City staff added that the Public Hearing was adequately and appropriately advertised by both the City of Chesapeake and FIGG. Mr. Davis reminded Committee members that the comment period ends Monday, June 11 and the Committee will provide a report to City Council on June 12. Committee members were encouraged to provide their comments to be added to the report to City Council no later than Monday, June 11. Mr. Zoeller expressed some concerns in regards to the lack of a commuter discount on the Jordan Bridge. Mr. Crum informed the Committee that the Jordan Bridge (FIGG) is currently developing an initiative to reward frequent users through a local business voucher program. The voucher program will be similar to the Recycling Perks program offered by the Tidewater Fiber Corporation to City recycling customers.

Mr. Davis reminded the Committee that the next Public Hearing for the Chesapeake Transportation System, which includes Dominion Boulevard/Steel Bridge and the Chesapeake Expressway is scheduled for Monday, June 18, 2012. Ms. Saunders and Mr. Cuneo provided an overview of the presentation that will be given at the Public Hearing. Mr. Davis and Mr. Zoeller expressed some concerns and had questions in regards to the proposed toll rate structures. Mr. Davis recommended that the first toll increase on the Dominion Boulevard/Steele Bridge be delayed until fiscal year 2019. Mr. Ekiert, Mr. Levine and City Staff were able to answer the

Committee's questions and provide them with additional information.
