PROJECT/LOCATION: 1401 Deep Creek Boulevard

APPLICANT: Robin Scott

PROPOSAL: In accordance with Section 26-528, of the Chesapeake City Code, the applicant seeks an **EXCEPTION** to construct a mobile home within the 50-foot landward and 50-foot seaward portions of the 100-foot RPA buffer. The total proposed additional impervious area will be 1,152 SF (896 SF in RPA).

SUBDIVISION/LOT #: Geneva Mobile Home Park / Lot 111 **WATERSHED:** Southern Branch of the Elizabeth River **TAX MAP SECTION/PARCEL:** 0256001001110

The CBPA Board **APPROVED** (7 - 0); Greene/Curling, Nowak and Spaur excused) the exception for a period of two years with the following stipulations:

- 1. Provide one (1) large canopy tree (LCT) in the RPA to mitigate the impact of the proposed additional impervious area within the RPA. Per Sec. VII(B) of the Chesapeake Bay Preservation Area Ordinance Specifications Manual, the tree canopy coverage requirement for encroachment into the RPA buffer is fifty percent (50%). See Appendix A of the Chesapeake Landscape Specifications Manual for recommended tree species.
- 2. No existing trees are to be removed during the installation process. If any trees are damaged or removed they shall be replaced in kind on a 1:1 ratio.

PROPOSAL: In accordance with Section 26-528, of the Chesapeake City Code, the applicant seeks an **EXCEPTION** to construct a single family home and driveway within the 50-foot landward and 50-foot seaward portions of the 100-foot RPA buffer. The total proposed additional

impervious area will be 2,593 SF (2,593 SF in RPA). **SUBDIVISION/LOT #:** Parkview Block 4 Section 2 / Lot 4 **WATERSHED:** Southern Branch of the Elizabeth River

TAX MAP SECTION/PARCEL: 0344002003280

The CBPA Board **APPROVED** (7 - 0; Klesch/James, Nowak and Spaur excused) the exception for a period of two years with the following stipulations:

- 1. Provide thirteen (13) large canopy trees (LCT) and one (1) small canopy tree in the RPA to mitigate the impact of the proposed additional impervious area within the RPA. Existing trees may count towards this requirement. Per Sec. VII(B) of the Chesapeake Bay Preservation Area Ordinance Specifications Manual, the tree canopy coverage requirement for encroachment into the RPA buffer is fifty percent (50%). See Appendix A of the Chesapeake Landscape Specifications Manual for recommended tree species.
- 2. A city standard concrete entrance and the two (2) nine (9) by eighteen (18) feet required parking spaces shall be installed.
