

South Norfolk Updates

Hot Projects

CASCADE BOULEVARD PARK

Public Works: The crash pad submittals were approved and the pads are on order for the light poles. Project is 98% complete.

Parks and Recreation: The lighting project is now complete. Staff is working with the park's users to organize an official grand opening ceremony.

CONSOLVO PARK

Public Works: The new curbs and the entire sidewalk are installed. The parking lot is graded and ready for paving. Portions of the electric service are installed and the soccer field light pole foundations are installed. The light poles were installed on February 22 and approximately 25% of the small fence has been installed. Project is 65% complete.



Parks and Recreation: There has been further progress on the sidewalks. Grading continues.



SOUTH NORFOLK LIBRARY

Public Works: The electric and data floor boxes along with the floor slab have been installed. The elevator/stairway opening to the second floor has been completed. The wall stud framing is 90% complete. The drywall installation continues while the second floor framing for soffits and walls has been completed. The plumbing rough-in is 80% complete and the electrical power rough-in is 85% complete. The HVAC ducts have been delivered and the structural steel fireproofing is complete. The elevator pit concrete walls have been installed. Project is 40% complete.

Project Updates

UTILITY-RELATED PAVEMENT REPAIRS

Public Utilities: Public Utilities will be investigating the sanitary sewer in the 1000 Block of Liberty Street. In order to minimize the impact to roadway users, the work is being coordinated with a planned closure of Liberty Street by the railroad to work on the railroad crossing. This work is scheduled to take place on February 26th.

ELIZABETH RIVER BOAT LANDING AND PARK

Parks and Recreation: A presentation will be made at the City Council Work Session on February 26, 2013 to introduce the conceptual design and master plan for the Elizabeth River Park.
