

South Norfolk Updates

Hot Projects

CASCADE BOULEVARD PARK

Public Works: Work is nearly complete. The final photometry test and data collection is scheduled for Jan 29. Project is 95% complete.

Parks and Recreation: The new lighting system is installed and operational. Final testing will be performed within the next week to ensure lighting measurement specifications are met and fixture adjustments completed. The lights have been on for several extended periods to ensure correct readings are performed.



CONSOLVO PARK

Public Works: New curbs and most of the sidewalks are installed. The parking lot is graded. Portions of the electric service are installed. Soccer field light pole foundation work has begun. Light poles and fixtures have been delivered. Project is 25% complete.

Parks and Recreation: Grading of the parking lot continues and light poles are now on site.



SOUTH NORFOLK LIBRARY

Public Works: Electric and data floor boxes are installed. Approximately 2/3 of the floor slab is installed. Fire proofing and wall framing are now taking place. Second floor framing for soffits and walls is complete. Project is 15% complete.

Project Updates

UTILITY-RELATED PAVEMENT REPAIRS

Public Utilities is finding and fixing cave-ins associated with sanitary sewer leaks. 802 Wilbur Ave Alleyway repair is complete; pictures attached. Ongoing sewer repair on 1100 block of Hoover Ave. The following areas have completed repairs: 1320 Chesapeake Ave; waiting paving: 914 Edgewood Ave. There are several locations being managed; they will be repaired if they become unsafe or nonoperational. They are as follows: Bainbridge Blvd. at Park Ave; 2701 Bainbridge Ave., 904 Avalon Ave.; 2700 Blk of Bainbridge Blvd.; Westwood Ave. and Avalon Ave.; 1333 Chesapeake Ave.; 2020 Portlock Rd.; Faye St. between Omar St. and Mark St.





ELIZABETH RIVER BOAT LANDING AND PARK

Parks and Recreation: Grading is being completed around the entrance to the park. The park and boat ramp remain closed.



CASCADE PARK

Parks and Recreation: Although the athletic lights at the facility have been shut off since December, the system experienced several malfunctions during the past week. Faulty wiring led to the lights being activated without prompting on at least three occasions. Circuits and wiring have now been repaired. There have been no additional issues at the facility since the repair was completed.
