

VIRGINIA: IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF THE CITY OF CHESAPEAKE

IN RE: SECOND ORDER REGARDING ADDITIONAL COURTHOUSE SECURITY, HEALTH, AND SAFETY MEASURES DURING COVID-19 EMERGENCY

On May 15, 2020, the Court entered an Order Regarding Additional Courthouse Security, Health, and Safety Measures During COVID-19 Emergency, which is incorporated herein;

Due to the increasing proliferation and spread of the Covid-19 virus and incidents of symptomatic individuals entering the Courthouse, in addition to the requirements set forth the Order of May 15, 2020, it is

ORDERED and DECREED as follows:

The Sheriff shall screen the temperature of each person entering the Courthouse and shall deny entrance to anyone with a measured temperature of 100.4° F (38° C) or greater, pursuant to CDC guidelines.

A willful violation of this order may be punished as contempt under Virginia Code § 18.2-456. This order shall be in effect until rescinded by the Court.
