GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF CLASS

The purpose of the class is to provide basic technical engineering support in assigned area. The class is responsible for determining costs for various aspects of project development, assisting with project inquiries, and preparing and updating plans. The class works within a general outline of work to be performed; develops work methods and sequences under general supervision.

TYPICAL TASKS

- Determining costs for various aspects of project development such as street and utility improvements.
- Prepares and updates project plans.
- Researches deed records of property ownership and other project information.
- Tracks, prepares, and maintains contract documentation.
- Assists the general public with project inquiries.
- Prepares reports summarizing project information such as subdivision footage.
- Performs related tasks as necessary such as conducting designated engineering studies.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.
