**Yellow Wood Sorrel** (*Oxalis stricta*)

**Find me:** Down by the river, left field

**Blooms:** March - April



**Primrose leaved Violet** (*Viola primulifolia*)

**Fun Fact:** Hybrid of two other native violets

**Find me:** Where Deer Island and Shuttle trail connect

**Blooms:** April - June



**Common Blue Violet** (*Viola sororia*)

**Find me:** In the campgrounds, at the base of trees

**Blooms:** April - June

**False Garlic** (*Nothoscordum bivalve*)

**Find me:** Down by the river, in the tree line

**Blooms:** March - April



**Azure Bluet** (*Houstonia Caerulea*)

**Find me:** Along the sides of the Shuttle trail

**Blooms:** April - July



**Eastern Daisy Fleabane** (*Erigeron Annuus*)

**Fun Fact:** This flower gets its name from the superstition that dried clusters of these plants could be used to rid a dwelling of fleas.

**Find me:** Between Molly Mitchell and Otter Point trailheads

**Blooms:** June - October

**Atamasco Lily** (*Zephyranthes Atamasca*)

**Find me:** Along Molly Mitchell trail or down by the river, near the water

**Blooms:** March - April
