

Electoral Board Meeting August 6, 2018

The Chesapeake Electoral Board met in the Office of the General Registrar on Wednesday, August 6, 2018 at 9:00 A.M. Those in attendance were:

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m.

Duane motioned to adopt the minutes from the May 2, 2018. Being no opposition, the board unanimously voted to adopt the minutes as presented.

General Registrar Mary Lynn Pinkerman presented the agenda for the day.

Mary Lynn updated the Board on the scanning of the alpha files into VERIS. A motion was made by Duane McNair that the policy will be that once an alpha card is scanned into VERIS, the electronic copy becomes the official copy, once verified and associated with the voter. The motion was seconded by Beth Banks and carried.

Mary Lynn proposed polling place changes to the Board.

1. Due to a termination of lease by Greenbrier Church, Fairways precinct (0053) should be relocated from Greenbrier Church (1101 Volvo Parkway) to First Norfolk Church (1516 Volvo Parkway).
2. Due to termination of lease by River Oak Church, Expressway precinct (0058) should be relocated from River Oak Church (255 Great Bridge Blvd.) to Mount Olive Baptist Church (662 Fernwood Farms Rd.).
3. Per a request by the schools, Georgetown precinct (0012) should be relocated from Indian River Middle School (2300 Old Greenbrier Road) to Indian River Community Center (2250 Old Greenbrier Road).
4. Due to ADA issues at the school, Shipyard Road precinct (0052) possibly could be relocated from Deep Creek Central Elementary School (2448 Shipyard Road) to Grassfield Baptist Church (1772 Cedar Road) pending a decision by the church and ADA approval by the Municipal Facilities Administrator, Tim Winslow.

A motion was made by Duane McNair that each polling place change be accepted and sent to City Council as soon as possible for approval. The motion was seconded by Beth Banks and carried.

A letter submitted on behalf of VRAV/VEBA to the House Select Committee on School Safety in regards to the moving of the June primaries from the second to the third Tuesday in June was discussed.

Keith presented two Election Official issues to the Board. The personnel issues were discussed and an action decided on each.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:15 a.m.
