- **Agenda: Provisional Ballot Meeting and Canvass for the November 3, 2020 General Election**

Beth Banks called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Dave moved to take a recess from Canvass to enter into the Provisional Ballot Counting Session. All approved.

After answering questions from a few visiting Provisional voters, the Board started the examination of the Provisional Ballots, at 10:45 a.m.

The board examined Provisional Ballots. There were 891 Provisional Ballots to process. After review and research were complete, 583 were determined valid, mostly due to absentee voting.

The Provisional Ballot Meeting was completed Friday November 6, 2020 at 9:30 a.m.

After a short break, Beth called the Canvass to order at 10:00 a.m.

The board examined the Statement of Results #1 and #2 for each precinct. The results on the tapes were compared to the totals reported Election Night and corrections were made. The meeting was adjourned on November 6, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.

The meeting on Monday, November 9, 2020 at 8:30 am reconvened and continued until 10:15 a.m. to continue Canvass. A move was made to reconvene and conclude the meeting on Tuesday, November 10, 2020 at 9:00 a.m.

The meeting reconvened on Tuesday November 10, 2020 at 9:00 a.m.

The final numbers were affirmed and abstracts were signed for the November 3, 2020 General Election.

Beth reported that the Registrar's office will be honored at the City Council Meeting to be held on December 8, 2020 at 6:30 p.m.

It was decided that the next meeting of the board would be the first week of January 2021.

The motion was made to adjourn by Dave at 9:45 am, seconded by Duane and was agreed on unanimously.
