

Electoral Board Meeting July 19, 2021

The Chesapeake Electoral Board met in the Office of the General Registrar on Monday, July 19, 2021 at 9:00 A.M.

Susan Cobb called the meeting to order at 9:35 a.m.

The board discussed Satellite Early Voting locations for the November 2, 2021 General Election. David made a motion to use Central Library – 298 Cedar Road, 23322, Greenbrier Library – 1214 Volvo Parkway, 23320, Indian River Library – 2320 Old Greenbrier Road, 23325, Major Hillard Library – 824 Old George Washington Highway, North, 23323 and Russell Memorial Library – 2808 Taylor Road, 23321 as well as the Dr. Clarence V. Cuffee Community Center – 2019 Windy Road, 23324 as Satellite Early Voting locations from September 17- October 30. The hours will be 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday as well as 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. the last two Saturdays before the election. The motion was seconded by Duane and carried unanimously.

The board discussed the July 1 law change allowing voting on Sundays. David made a motion that voting be held at the Registrar's Office on Sunday, October 3, 2021 from noon until 4:00 p.m. Duane seconded the motion, Susan voted no, and the motion passed.

David made a motion to move into closed session at 10:25 a.m. to perform the Annual General Registrar Performance Review. Susan seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously.

Duane made a motion to call the meeting back to order at 10:45 a.m. Susan seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

The Board states that nothing was discussed in closed session, except for the personnel matters that the meeting was intended.

Mary Lynn discussed the need to purchase additional voting equipment and election supplies to be designated specifically for the early voting satellite locations. David made a motion to purchase the necessary voting equipment and election supplies for the early voting satellite locations. Susan seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously.

The motion was made to adjourn by David at 11:05 a.m., seconded by Susan and was agreed on unanimously.
