To Whom It May Concern:

For matters related to the issuance of municipal securities and municipal financial products related to the Chesapeake Transportation System, the City of Chesapeake is providing the following written disclosure to be relied upon by market participants for purposes of the independent registered municipal advisor exemption to the Securities and Exchange Commission Municipal Advisor Rule (17 C.F.R. § 240.15Ba1-1, et. seq.) (the "Rule").

The City of Chesapeake has retained Raymond James & Associates, Inc., a municipal advisor that is registered under the Rule, as its municipal advisor for matters related to the Chesapeake Transportation System. The City will rely on its municipal advisor to provide advice regarding materials provided by financial services firms concerning the issuance of municipal securities and municipal financial products for the Chesapeake Transportation System.

Financial services firms may rely upon this disclosure until the earlier of (1) December 31, 2023, and (2) written notice to the contrary is provided by the City of Chesapeake.


